

Trench Closer Parts

- Mainframe
- Adjustable 3-PT Hitch Assembly (x2)
- Disc Blade Assembly (x4)
 2 extra optional
- 26" Disc Blade (x4)
 - \circ 2 extra optional
- ³/₄" U-Bolt (x12)
- Hook Point



Adjustable 3PT Assembly

The 3PT Assembly can be adjusted to fit a Category II, Category III Narrow, Category III, or Category IV Quick Hitch. To adjust, use a 1 ¹/₄" Imperial Wrench to loosen the four U-Bolts on the 3PT Assembly and slide in or out to the desired width. Insert the upper pin into the appropriate hole for the desired quick hitch.

If the Trench Closer is going to be used on a 3PT without a Quick Hitch, adapter pins or bushings may be needed.



Disc Assembly

The disc assembly can be adjusted from 15-25 degrees. To adjust, loosen the U-Bolts and turn the assembly to the desired angle.



Trench Closer Operating Instructions

- 1) Adjust the 3PT Assemblies to the appropriate width for the tractor that will be attached to the Trench Closer.
- 2) Attach the Trench Closer to a tractor with a Category II, Category III Narrow, Category III, or Category IV Quick Hitch.
- 3) Adjust the Disc Assemblies to the desired width and angle on the mainframe.
- 4) Straddle the tile line you will be closing or mounding over.
- 5) Lower the Trench Closer to the desired depth.
- 6) Drive forward while straddling the tile line.

The Tile Cutter is available in Small or Large sizes. It can be used to easily cut tile in one swipe when stringing tile out and when cutting mains for connections.
